

Camp News...OCTOBER 2024 Fall is here and we are as busy as ever loving and serving the churches and community!

Last month our Homework Helpers and American Sign Language Classes started back on Mondays.

We also held our monthly Saturday Day Camp combined with WMU Children's Missions Day on September 21st where we learned about the Amazon River and Rainforest and the missionaries serving

the people there. We made popsicle stick "tiles" as part of the WMU/Cooperative Program "Houseboat Project".

For the first time, we offered a community CPR/Lifesaving Class taught by certified instructors and hope to offer this again in the future.

One other highlight of last month was that our Sign Language instructor, Dr. Adonia Smith, and I attended the Georgia Baptist SPARK Conference together. It was a wonderful experience worshiping with many deaf people (with plenty of fluent interpreters on hand) and learning about needs and challenges of ministering to deaf people in our community. Disaster Relief continues to be very busy. After getting the unit cleaned, sanitized, and reset from the Statesboro callout it didn't have to wait long before callout to duty again. Hurricane Helene roared through Georgia causing all kinds of destruction.

Thank God it spared our area mostly.



On 9/28 Our Disaster Relief group served in Rome helping a church that flooded from all the rains before and during the storm.

On 9/29 Glenn Robinson left with the unit headed to serve in Alma, Georgia. After reaching Alma Sunday afternoon, he was redirected to Vidalia Monday morning. Alabama and Mississippi came to Alma to handle everything there.

On 9/30 the rest of the team arrived in Vidalia. The town was without power but thanks to Arkansas for bringing in a large generator to power the church. The team has been wide open cutting trees and tarping roofs. This will be an extended period of work for a long time.

Baptist Disaster Relief kitchens are preparing about 50,000 meals a day in Georgia alone. Southern Baptist Disaster Relief is operating 20 disaster relief sites in the southeast. 6 states are here helping Georgia. 64 counties were damaged in Georgia and we have teams serving in 5 different cities. Storm Responses like this are when we really need people like you to be able to serve. We have 1.5 teams manned. People need help badly.

Also, on 9/30 a group of Disaster Relief men and women helped a homeowner in Cedartown. They had a huge oak fall on their home during the storm. The tree destroyed the roof. After clearing the tree from the roof these men and women tarped the roof to help prevent further damage. Disaster Relief needs more volunteers.

We especially need younger people to get involved. The average age of the people tarping the roof Monday was 75. Ages ranged from late 50s to late 80s. 3 were in there 80's.

Living for Christ in the Public Square: Roopville Road Baptist Church



PRAY FOR THE MIDDLE EAST


The intense conflict in the Middle East is a reason for Christians to pray. Thousands of people have been killed since Hamas attacked Israel on Oct. 7.


- Romans 13 where we learn that God has given governing authorities to protect the innocent and bring justice to evil doers.
